Information About Early Childhood Education in Seinäjoki

What is Early Childhood Education?

Early childhood education in Finland is not just childcare. It supports the child's learning, development, and well-being. It is part of the Finnish education system. Early childhood education continues until the child starts school (the year the child turns 7).

Applying for a placement in Early Childhood Education



Apply for early childhood or pre-primary education electronically: https://seinajoki.daisynet.fi/eDaisy

If you cannot apply online, contact: Sari Salmenoja - sari.salmenoja@seinajoki.fi

You can list two daycare preferences, but the placement may not match your wishes. If nearby daycare centers are full, your child may be placed in another part of the city. Transportation is not provided.

You will receive a decision about the placement approximately two weeks before the start date.

Placement Timeframe

If both parents are working or studying, a place will be arranged within two weeks of receiving the application.

If only one parent is working or studying, the waiting time can be up to four months.



Attendance Hours (1)



The length of the child's daycare day depends on the parent's work or study schedule. Attendance hours must be booked in advance via Daisy. https://seinajoki.daisyfamily.fi/login

Changes must be reported in advance. Sick children must not be brought to daycare.

Children must have weather-appropriate clothing:

In winter:

Snowsuit, wool overall, neck warmer, hat, mittens, winter boots

In spring/summer/autumn:

Outdoor suit, light hat, rain gear, rubber boots

Additionally:

Spare clothes (pants, shirt, socks, underwear) Indoor shoes, comfort toy, pacifier, diapers (if needed) Label all clothing with the child's name

8:30 - Play / outdoor activities



Autumn break: week 42 Winter break: week 9

Daycare centers are closed on public holidays (except for the 24-hour daycare Taika)

Summer break: (June - July)

Some daycare centers will be open during the summer break. They will be announced during

spring.

Public holidays in Finland include:

New Year's Day (January 1)
Epiphany (January 6)
Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Easter Monday
May Day (May 1)
Ascension Thursday (May)
Midsummer's Day (June)
Independence Day (December 6)
Christmas (December 24-26)

Daycare centers are closed on public holidays (except for the Taika daycare center).

Cooperation with Parents 🤝

Parents and daycare staff work together to support the child's development. There are parent meetings and discussions (e.g., early education plan meetings - VASU).

Language and Culture 🧪

Children receive support in learning Finnish.

Daycares value the child's own language and culture.

Interpretation or translated materials can be provided if needed.

Fees are based on family income.

Low-income families may receive discounts or free early childhood education.
